"Judge not"	does	not	mean
-------------	------	-----	------

- 1. That we suspend the rule of law (Rom. 13; Matt. 18)
- 2. That we turn off our brains (John 7:24; 1 John 4:1; Matt. 7:6, 15)

#### "Judge not" does mean...

- I. Christians are not to exhibit a \_\_\_\_\_\_ spirit toward others (vv. 1-2)
  - 1. Judging harshly (Matt. 18)
  - 2. Judging rashly
  - 3. Judging unmercifully (James 2:13; Gal. 6:1)
  - 4. Being a faultfinder (Prov. 19:11)
  - 5. Mountains and mole hills
  - 6. Applying our own standards to others (Rom. 14:10-13)

Application (living in light of two great judgments)
Judgment past (Rom. 3:19)
Judgment future (2 Cor. 5:10)

II. Christians are not to be \_\_\_\_\_\_in their views of others (vv. 3-5)
